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DROP OFF: Please drop off your camper at the Marjorie Alkek Fine Arts Center 239 College Park Dr., Weatherford, TX 76086 between 8:10 and 8:20 am. Family members of campers are welcome before 8:25 and after 4:20. Please notify the staff at this time if somebody different will be picking up your child. Be sure your child is in the building before you leave.

Camp staff will be available at all times. Please do not pick up your camper early without locating and notifying appropriate staff. If you know in advance that your camper will need to be picked up earlier on certain days please provide this to us in advance if possible. We understand that this situation may arise, but please understand that your camper could miss valuable Information and instruction by leaving early.

Afternoon Pick Up: Instruction is over at 4:30 every day and we will make every effort to stick to this schedule. Please pick your youth up no later than 4:40 PM.

SPECIAL NEEDS: If there are any special considerations that you feel we need to be aware of regarding your youth (medications, allergies, behavioral problems, illnesses, etc.), please let us know prior to arriving to camp so that we can best accommodate your youth.

GROUND RULES: It is our goal to ensure that each youth has an enjoyable and fulfilling experience as a participant at Y Bar J Youth Western Music and Poetry Camp. We will always emphasize positive ways to deal with any situation that might arise. Children must stay with their designated faculty member.
